Please do write in to the Heritage Centre with any name corrections and any other memories. This does not appear to have been a formal set of class photos, but perhaps ones taken on the initiative of a teacher. The print size is what was common to Box Brownie cameras.

Bob Trowbridge, though not in this particular photo, recalls that Rene Howe and Dorothy Atkins were favourite teachers at the time. Rene had a succession of white miniature poodles all named Kim: they always came to class. Bob Lived at St. Lawrence and the village kids there were taken to school in the van that was used to deliver the school dinners. One precious memory was of Kwaku Appiah, a Ghanaian boy who attended the school. He was the first black person Bob had ever seen, but he was just 'one of the lads': it was a time when racism seemed not to have been invented. Rita Gawn, again not in the picture, recalls being taken by

coach for swimming lessons at the Blue Lagoon in Sandown, films being shown in a Nissen Hut on the 'bottom plateau', and the daily supply of milk in glass bottles. They were 'happy days', looking back.
